



## Urgent call for all humanitarians to join us in condemning gross violations of human right in Oromia (Ethiopia)

We call upon all the international community to stand with the Oromo nation currently subjected to State-terrorism following the Gruesome assassination of the Oromo's iconic pop star- Singer and Song writer- Hachelu Hundessa- in the Ethiopian Capital (Finfinnee/Addis Ababa) on June 29, 2020. The Oromo Community Scotland (OCS) is shocked and saddened after learning the premature execution of the Oromo's prominent voice whose Songs and Lyrics mobilised the Oromo revolution of 2015-2018 that has brought the previous barbaric regime to its knees. Following his assassination, over 500 protestors were executed in Oromia's national state by the military and security forces of the government of the Ethiopian PM, Abiy Ahmed who is the 2019 Noble peace Prize Laureate- who suddenly became ruthless dictator. Moreover, hundreds of Oromo's high profile nationalist politicians were unlawfully incarcerated and tens of thousands of Oromo civilians were mass arrested where the torture is rampant.

As silence whilst humanity is at stake never pleases civilised humanitarians; we call upon International community including the UK and the Scottish governments to join us in categorically denouncing the brutal massacre of the Oromo civilians; and the ongoing state-terrorism in Ethiopia's Oromia state. We also call upon the international community to join us in demanding the Ethiopian government to bring those who have assassinated Hachelu Hundessa to justice and to unconditionally release all the Oromo's political prisoners.
